Have you seen the new <u>elogbook</u>? 28,000 operations were entered in the first week and there have been surprisingly few bugs. There is a new launch <u>help page</u> for up to date information and as usual, please do let us know of any other new issues.

Don't Panic!

For a few weeks you can still access the <u>old elogbook site</u> - this will be closed down fully soon.

What do I need to do?

- TPDs have a look at who is in your training programme and correct the lists as required
- 2. Trainees Ensure your year in training and trainee type are correct

Bugs already identified and fixed

- Trainer reports for TPD's and procedure by trainer report now working
- SAC report for general surgery now displays column for assisted
- SAC report groups with age limits now display correctly
- Date ordering in browse operations now displaying correctly
- Consultants now displaying correctly when editing an operation
- Favourites now display in alphabetical order
- Operation date & consultant are now carried forward to the next operation
- When adding a Paediatric operation, Gestation is no longer a required field
